- 1. <u>Judge Recusal</u> of Justice Jonathan Brunet given:
 - a. "The Smoking Gun of '21" (aka denied Third-party Records Application: see https://pfi.rocks/mummygate/scenes/the-smoking-gun),
 - b. the original charges
 - c. and the 20220524/27 result.
- 2. **Probation Review** given:
 - a. no crime ever committed:
 - i. Section 349(1)—"Every person who, without lawful excuse, enters or is in a dwelling-house with intent to commit an indictable offence" (See 2019 disclosure and Tab 9b ordering "co-operation" which husband had refused for over five moths (ie. Kiska's violation of S. 127, multiple counts).
 - ii. Section 430(7)—no Mischief
 - iii. No B&E, no criminal harassment, no harm to anyone: just a child-abusing Non-communication Order and restraining order so Kiska could avoid a divorce.
 - b. 2022 pre-sentencing package never sent by lawyer or received by Crown/court (see https://pfi.rocks/mummygate/2022-pre-sentencing-package).
